ATTACHMENTS

USING YOUR ATTACHMENTS SAFELY



SAFETY



For optimal safety, always use Manitou APPROVED attachments.



Drive according to your visibility over the load.



Check condition of the forks/attachments and check that they are locked in place.



Drive with forks lowered.



Check compatibility of the machine and attachments/forks.



Do not use the fork positioner as a gripper.



Use your attachments only for what they were designed to do.



Never attempt to modify the attachment's safety systems.



Check your work environment and see if there are any people present.



Never exceed the capacity of the attachment



SUSPENDED LOADS



Check the condition of your attachment's cable/strap/sling gear and replace if necessary.



Adjust your driving and speed to prevent load sway.



NEVER pick up big bags on the forks; use an appropriate attachment.



Use suspended load mode properly.



Do not use the "lugs" of the machine's fork carriage as a gripper.

PERSONNEL LIFTING



When using a platform, mark out your work area.



When working with a platform, wear a harness and helmet.



For all work at height, keep away from power lines.



Use an appropriate platform for all personnel lifting (only on machine equipped for personnel lifting).



When working with a platform, do not lean over.



NEVER use the buckets to lift people.

MAINTENANCE



Remember to grease your attachment.
